The 2018 Community Event will be very exciting featuring many exciting event including a Color Run, Craft Fair, Community Displays, Carnival Booths, food vendors, and a car show. This event should attract a large crowd for everyone! We are still working hard to bring in more activities to make this year a great celebration!

The 2018 Vendor set-up will be both inside and outside. We are still taking a look at the logistics of the Community Day set-up and it is our intention to create a layout that has a good "flow" to it. Each indoor and outdoor exhibit space is 10' x 10' in size. There is a \$25 fee for each inside exhibit space and \$20 for each outside exhibit space needed.

(Limited inside spaces available.) Set-up times will be in the morning on Saturday, May 5th. All booths must be set-up by 9:45 a.m. Set-up for your exhibit should be limited to one hour as a courtesy to other exhibitors. You must provide an e-mail address for your confirmation information to be sent electronically.

Please complete and return the enclosed application, along with your check or money order to the address provided. Be sure to read the rules and regulations. Directions and further information will be provided with your reservation confirmation.

**2018 Yermo School Vendor Show
Rules & Regulations**

1. Vendor Show hours are Saturday, May 5, 2017, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. If a participant wishes to tear down early, please notify a member of the vendor show staff before doing so in order for possible arrangements to be made. No vehicles will be allowed on show sites during Community Day hours.
2. Vendor Show participants will be allowed to drive their vehicles up to their outside booths during scheduled set-up time and scheduled tear-down time ONLY. Inside booths (available on a limited basis) will have a designated loading area. At all other times, vehicles must remain in the designated parking areas. This is to ensure the safety of customers and spectators, as there will be excessive foot traffic.
3. Vendor Show set-up time will be Saturday, May 5th, beginning at 8 a.m. (no earlier) until 9:45 a.m. Directions for set-up will be sent with confirmations via e-mail. Site assignments will be given upon arrival at your set-up time.
4. Booth size is 10' x 10'. Tents and canopies are allowed, but stakes (not allowed for inside booths) may NOT be driven into the cement. However, weighted anchors are highly recommended. Some examples of weighted anchors are 5-gallon buckets filled with water or cement or milk jugs filled with water or cement. All sites are located on school grounds. **There are limited spaces available inside and overflow spaces will be outside.**
5. Outside only: The use of a generator at the Vendor Show is allowed, as long as you have a sound barrier and an exhaust filter. Generators will be inspected at the time of arrival and set-up. There will NOT be access to electricity. Participants must provide their own tables and chairs.
6. Yermo School Vendor Show expects participants to carry liability insurance for their own protection.
7. Participants will receive confirmation of set-up time and directions within one week of the fair. You must provide an e-mail address on your application.
8. Trash receptacles will be located throughout the fair for the convenience of the participants and may NOT be brought into individual booths.
10. The sale of real weapons, drug paraphernalia, or alcohol abuse related items is prohibited.

* Please note: Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in the termination of Vendor Show participation.

**VOLUNTARY ACTIVITY WAIVER, RELEASE & INDEMNITY
AGREEMENT**

For and in consideration of permitting _____ to enroll in and participate in Yermo School Spring Carnival, Car Show Craft Fair, & Community Event in the City of Yermo, County of San Bernardino, State of California, beginning on the 5th day of May, 2018, the undersigned hereby voluntarily releases, discharges, waives and relinquishes any and all actions or causes of action for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to him/herself arising as a result of engaging or receiving instructions in said activity or any activities incidental thereto wherever or however the same may occur and continue, and the undersigned does for him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby release, waive, discharge and relinquish any action or causes of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for him/herself and for his/her estate, and agrees that under no circumstances will he/she or his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns prosecute, present any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against (district) or any of its officers, agents or employees for any of said causes of action, whether the same shall arise by the negligence of any of said persons, or otherwise.

It is the intention of (participant) by this instrument, to exempt and relieve (district) from liability for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death caused by negligence.

The undersigned, for him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, agrees that in the event any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death shall be prosecuted against (district), he/she shall indemnify and save harmless the same (district) from any and claims or causes of action by whomever or wherever made or presented for personal injuries, property damage or wrongful death.

The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has read the foregoing Waiver of Liability Notice and the foregoing three (3) paragraphs, has been fully and completely advised of the potential dangers incidental to engaging in the activity and instructing of Vendor Show, and is fully aware of the legal consequences of signing the within instrument.
